# CERTIFIED CONSTRUCTION MANAGER

## INDUSTRY - GOVERNMENT

**PRINCIPAL /CORPORATE EXECUTIVE (20-30 YRS):** Executive leadership directing business strategy. Engages with clients and seeks business development opportunities. Provides oversight for projects associated with multiple industry sectors.

**PROGRAM MANAGER/DIRECTOR (15-20 YRS):** Manages multiple large construction projects for the project owner. Provides oversight and mentorship to construction managers. Engages with stakeholders and seeks new business opportunities for the firm.

**SENIOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGER (10-15 YRS):** Effectively manages large or complex construction projects. Leads negotiations for complex change orders and provides expertise and mentorship. Ideally you would be certified as a CCM and/or hold a P.E. license.

**CONSTRUCTION MANAGER (5-10 YRS):** Eligible to take the Certified Construction Manager certification (CCM). You are experienced in the construction process and can effectively manage all stakeholders as the project owner's representative. You manage a small team to provide oversight over the entire project directly for the owner.

**OFFICE ENGINEER/PROJECT COORDINATOR/ASSISTANT CONSTRUCTION MANAGER (0-5 YRS):** Learn to be a construction manager through on-the-job and formal training while working under a licensed Professional Engineer and/or a Certified Construction Manager. You can pass the FE exam if coming straight out of college and certify as a Construction Manager-in-Training (CMIT).
